ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

THIS CLUB DOES NOT AGREE TO ARBITRATE CLAIMS AS SET FORTH ON THE OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORM FOR THIS EVENT.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Additionally, clubs should include any specific local or state health requirements; for example, proof of rabies vaccination.

- Fees must accompany entries. This Club and/or Trial Secretary assume no responsibility for incomplete or wrong information on the entry form, or for a dog being entered in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete, or for entering the same dog twice.

Awards won but not picked up at the show will not be mailed to the winner and the awardforfeited.

HDOC holds a yearly AKC licensed Obedience Trial in May, and an AKC licensed Tracking Test in the spring and fall.

- Demonstrate dog obedience to the general public; build individual dog's selfconfidence. Many members have therapy dogs that visit local hospitals, schools, and retirement homes.
- Create a costume for your dog for the annual Halloween Party.
- Monthly meeting current interesting subjects to dog owners, field trips with dogs to the beach, hikes and picnics at parks; occasional dining with our dogs at local restaurants.
